## GENERAL SAFETY INFORMATION

## LIMITED WARRANTY

Tennsco warrants goods purchased hereunder to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment, hereunder. This warranty shall not apply in the event goods are damaged as a result of misuse, abuse, neglect, accident, improper application, modification or repair by persons not authorized by Seller, where goods are damaged during shipment, or where the date stamps on the goods have been defaced, modified or removed. 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## ASSEMBLY OF THREE WIDE DOUBLE TIER LOCKERS

Tools Needed: A provided 11/32" nut driver (11/32" socket may be substituted).
Two people are recommended for assembly. Approximate assembly time: 40-50 minutes.

1. The reference numbers used throughout this sheet refer to the illustration on the back cover. This is to help you to identify the various parts as they are mentioned.
2. Unpack all parts, locate the left and right hand sides and seperate them. The top of the sides and back can be deter mined by the three holes closest to the end of the part. Place the back (Ref. No. 1) on a protected flat surface so that the flanges face upward. If available, place the unit on a pair of saw horses for easier assembly.

3. Bolt the left side (Ref. No. 2) to the back so that the side flange fits around back using seven bolts and nuts (Ref. No. 20) placing the nuts on the inside of the locker, if assembling a locker with legs. If assembling a locker without legs, use nine nuts and bolts.

4. Bolt the top, middle and bottom shelves (Ref. No. 4) to the back and side using four bolts and nuts each. Coat hooks will need to be attached over the flange of the shelves as shown. Use two bolts and nuts per each coat hook. Next bolt an intermediate side and back panel to the flange on the back of the first locker in seven places (nine if no legs). Attach another top, middle, and bottom shelf to the first intermediate side and back. These will share bolts with the parts on either side of them as shown in detail below. Next attach the remaining intermediate side, and back as well as the to middle and bottom shelves as stated before.

5. Bolt the right side (Ref. No. 6) to the back so that the side flange fits around the back also attaching to the top, middle and bottom shelves using sixteen nuts and bolts if the locker has no legs and eighteen nuts and bolts for a locker with legs.

6. If the locker has legs, insert the leg into the corner between the bottom

7. Place the door and frame assembly (Ref. No. 7) over the locker body. Make certain that body sides are inside the frames. Attach the top to the frame header and the bottom to the frame sill.

8. If joining units side by side, temporarily install a bolt and nut into the third and sixth holes down from the top of the outer frame(s) that will be joined to the adjacent locker frame(s). The center locker frame can be bolted complete. If the locker is just a stand alone unit, finish attaching the frames using thirty-eight bolts and nuts. Check and tighten all permanent bolts.

9. Stand the unit upright and place in the desired location. Remove temporary bolts in frames and bolt to adjacent units together through frames.
NOTE: If the temporary bolts are not removed before the frames are joined side by side, the frames will have a $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ gap between them.

10. Anchor units to wall or floor. The units are not intended to stand free and may topple if not secured. Units standing back to back should be bolted back to back.
NOTE: Care must be taken to assure that lockers are set plumb and level before anchoring.
11. If units are not pre-numbered, optional number plates and plastic covers (Ref. No. 9) may be attached using push plugs (Ref. No. 10). Tennsco name plate (Ref. No. 18) is installed at the factory. As an alternative, custom number or name plates may be ordered from the factory. Your locker is complete.
12. If additional accessories were purchased such as End Bases/ Front Bases (for lockers with legs), Closed Bases (for lockers without legs), Slopping Tops, and/or Combination Locks or Grooved Key Locks, please see the instructions that came along with those parts for installation.

Door Frame assemblies require a further suffix ( $x$ ) of either 1 or $A$. " 1 " indicates frame with legs; " $A$ " indicates frame without legs. For example: $A$ door frame assembly for locker DTK-151536-1 (with legs) would be Part No. LDFA-1572-1. The door assembly alone without the frame for the same locker would be Part No. LDTD-1536.

NOTE: Additional hardware may be included for replacement purposes.
